The River Welland Catchment Board (Alteration of Boundaries of the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District) Order, 1950

Made - - - 12th June, 1950

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "River Welland Catchment Board (Alteration of Boundaries of the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District) Order, 1950".
- 2. The Scheme in relation to the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District (together with the map referred to therein) submitted to him by the River Welland Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of the said Act, a copy of which Scheme is annexed hereto, is hereby confirmed.
- 3. The expenses of the Minister in connection with the making and confirmation of this Order shall be borne by the Catchment Board and shall be part of the administrative expenses of the Catchment Board.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930

The River Welland Catchment Board

The River Welland Catchment Board in pursuance of Sub-section (1) (b) of Section 4 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, have prepared the following Scheme making provision for certain matters mentioned in the said Section which is supplemental to the Scheme setting up the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage Board which came into force on the first day of April One thousand nine hundred and thirty nine(a) (hereinafter referred to as the original scheme) and to the supplementary Scheme whereby the Bourne and Thurlby Internal Drainage District was added to that of the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District which Scheme came into force on the first day of April One thousand nine hundred and forty three(b) and to a second supplemental Scheme whereby certain lands in the parish of Deeping Saint James were added to the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District which Scheme came into force on the first day of November one thousand nine hundred and forty six(c) viz.:—

- 1. THE addition to the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District of a portion of the town of Spalding and shown by the colour Pink on the map attached to this scheme.
 - 2. CERTAIN matters supplemental thereto and consequent thereon.

And the Catchment Board submit the Scheme to the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") for confirmation under Section 4 of the Act.

Scheme

As from a day (hereinafter referred to as "the appointed day") to be appointed by the Minister the following provisions shall have effect:—

- 1. There shall be added to and included in the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District (hereinafter called "the Deeping Fen District") the lands coloured Pink on the map sealed by the Catchment Board in relation to this Scheme.
- 2. The Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage Board (hereinafter called "the Deeping Fen Board") shall have all the powers of a Drainage Board under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, with regard to the said lands as if the same were part of the Deeping Fen, Spalding and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District as constituted by the original Scheme.
- 3. ELECTORAL division C as provided for in Clause 6 of the original Scheme setting up the Deeping Fen Board shall include the lands coloured pink on the map sealed by the Catchment Board in relation to this Scheme together with the lands coloured Yellow on the 1 inch key map annexed to the 6 inch map scaled in relation to the original scheme.
- 4. The powers of the Welland Drainage Board under the provisions of the Land Drainage Provisional Order Confirmation (No. 2) Act 1922, so far as they are exercisable within the lands hereby added to the Deeping Fen District shall be abrogated and cease to have effect.

- 5. All property, rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities vested in or to be discharged by the Welland Drainage Board to the extent to which the same relate to matters or things within the Area hereby added to the Deeping Fen District are hereby transferred to the Deeping Fen Board provided that in the event of any asset or liability being applicable only partially in relation to the Deeping Fen District an equitable adjustment shall be made and only the due proportion shall be transferred to and vested in the Deeping Fen Board and in the event of a dispute arising between that Board and the Welland Drainage Board the same shall be referred to and decided by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries whose decision shall be final.
- 6. The power to collect all rents due to and all rates (including arrears of rates) already made by the Welland Drainage Board in respect of any lands in the area hereby added to the Deeping Fen District and not collected by the appointed day together with powers and duties of the Drainage Board in relation thereto shall be transferred to the Deeping Fen Drainage Board.

THE COMMON SEAL of the River Welland Catchment Board is hereunto affixed this Fifteenth day of January One thousand nine hundred and fifty.
