MAXEY DRAINAGE BOARD

In pursuance of Section 24 (6) of the Land Drainage Act 1930 the Maxey Drainage Board hereby orders:

- (1) That the lands and hereditaments in the Drainage District be divided into two sub-districts as follows:
  - (a) the area consisting of 452 acres 2 roods 10 perches formerly known as the North Fen situate in the Parish of Deeping Gate and Northborough in the County of Northampton and shewn in red colour on the map sealed in relation to this Order
  - (b) the residue of the Board's district //
- (2) That the proportion which the amount per pound of annual value to be assessed upon the occupiers of hereditaments in the North Fen District shall bear to the amount to be assessed on the occupiers of the residue of the Board's District shall be the proportion of five to two.
