1. The Minutes of the meeting of the Board held on Wednesday the 13th April 1960 were read and confirmed and signed by the Chairman
2. The Auditors Report for the year ended 31st March 1959 was considered. The Accounts for the year ended the same date were also considered and it was noted that in the Occupiers Account there was a deficiency of £1,894: 3: 0½d while in the Owners Account there was a surplus of £9,314:18: 2½d. In view of the expenditure that was envisaged in the near future on new work it was decided not to take any special measures to reduce this balance.
3. It was proposed by Mr. Robinson and seconded by Mr. Neaverson and carried unanimously that the rate for the General District for the current year should be 5s. 8d, 1s. 0d Owners Rate and 4s. 8d Occupiers Rate and for the North Fen District 14s. 2d, 2s. 6d Owners Rate and 11s. 8d Occupiers Rate and it was proposed and seconded by the same persons that the rates should be sealed
4. The letter from Mr. Hampson with regard to the proposed letting of approximately one acre of grazing rights on the south bank of south drain Nine Bridges dated the 14th September last was considered and it was agreed that if the Engineer should have no objection a Tenancy Agreement should be prepared, Subject to the fences as mentioned in the letter being erected
5. The application from British Railways for permission to discharge effluent from the Septic Tanks proposed in connection with Numbers 1-10 Hurn Road was considered and the Clerk was instructed to get in touch with Mr. Hampson relating to this

6. With reference to matters arising from the minutes of the last meeting held on the 13th April last the Clerk was instructed to instruct the Engineer to obtain tenders for the construction of a secondary flap at the out-fall of the Northborough drain into the new cut

1. The Minutes of the meeting of the Board held on
Wednesday the 21st Sept^r 1960 and the meeting of
Electors for nomination of Members held on Tuesday
25th October 1960 were read confirmed & signed
by the Chairman when it was pointed out that at this meeting
it had been agreed that in future the notices to be laid in April or May.
2. The Chairman welcomed the new members
of the Board & said that Mr Jackson had sent
his apologies.
3. An apology was also sent by Mr Bracey
& a long letter from him to the Chairman was
read & discussed. It was decided that the
Board should continue as at present.

4. It was reported to the Board that a
letter had been received from Mr Hampton
intimating his desire to resign as Engineer
as from the 28th July next.

5. It was decided to ask the Newbrough
Drainage Board whether it would agree to this
Board approaching their Engineer Mr D.
Horsford as to the possibility of his being appointed
the Board's Engineer on a part time basis,
the Chairman to see him in which the
Newbrough Board's Chairman.
6. The Clerk reported that he had had a complaint
from Mr J. Webster of Elton that the Warminster
Dyke leading to Brook Drain was blocked thus
flooding his yard. The Clerk was instructed to write
to the Engineer.
7. It was reported by Mr H. Verette that when
the sewer was being laid from Elton Cross
towards the Helpston Cross water had been pumped
by the contractors from the trench into the dyke
with it shore from the trench bottom
thus sitting up the dyke. It was said that this
had occurred in other places in that area
while the sewer was being laid & the Clerk
was instructed to write to the Peterbyh R.D.C.

8. The Clerk reported that the Engineer had informed him that the New Flap for the New Cut had been ordered from ~~the~~ Farrow & Co Birmingham on the 19th Oct.

9. The Clerk reported that the Bainton Brook Scheme will not be completed as he was waiting to hear from the Engineer when the fence had been erected in his work on field at Bainton the watering place in that field completed.

1. The minutes of the last meeting were read confirmed & signed by the Chairman
2. The Chairman welcomed Mr Jackson to his first meeting.
3. The Board then considered the appointment of Mr D. S. S. Horsford as Engineer to the Board in place of Mr Hampson whose resignation was due to take effect on the 28th Feb 1961.
The Chairman reported that on the 23 Jan he with Mr Chamwell and Mr Hampson gone over the Board's District with Mr Horsford and he thought he would be satisfactory.
It was unanimously decided to offer him the post at a salary of £300 p.a. with £50 p.a. as a car allowance and further £25 as a payment for use of a room at his home as an office.
Mr Horsford then appeared before the

Board & accepted the post & the salary allowances offered. He was at the same time given the option of a salary of £325 p.a. with no payment for the use of a room at his home as an office & he said he would consider this.

The Clerk has instructed to make enquiries with the Clerk to the Newburgh Board with regard to sharing the expense of an Horsford's telephone.

4.3. The Clerk has instructed to ask the Peterhead R.C. if it would contribute 50% of the cost of fixing the small length of open dyke in the Rattray Road at that on.
