- 2. The Auditors Report for the year ended 31st March 1959 was considered. The Accounts for the year ended the same date were also considered and it was noted that in the Occupiers Account there was a deficiency of £1,894: 3: 0½d while in the Owners Account there was a surplus of £9,314:18: 2½d.
