Minutes of a Meeting of the Drainage Board of the Maxey District of
Drainage held at the Clerk's Office 37 Priestgate Peterborough on Wednesday
the 26th day of April 1961 at 11 am.

Present : Mr L.H.Vergette in the Chair
Messrs L.H.Samson, L.W.Hadman, H.A.Vergette, S.Egar, C.Neal, W.R.Neaverson,
W.H.Robinson, C.F.Naylor, M.Jackson, J.D.Perkins, W.J.A.Reynolds, Aubrey Crowson
and The Honourable P.F.Brassey.

1. The Minutes of the Meeting held on the 8th February last were read, confirmed and
signed by the Chairman

2. The Accounts for the year ended 31st March 1960 were approved and it was agreed in
view of the substantial balance at the Bank that £2,000 should be placed in a
Deposit Account

3. Matters arising from the Minutes.

Mr Horsford confirmed that he wished his salary to be treated as £300 per
annum, with a further £25 as a payment for the use of a room at his house as an

4. Mr Horsford then presented his Report having had an opportunity of inspecting
the Board's area and his report was as follows:

(a) He stated that the Brook Drain Scheme was of paramount importance and that this
must be done before anything effective could be done to relieve the Drainage
situation at Eton,

Mr H.A.Vergette referred to the pollution of the Board's drains in this
connection by the Helpston Paper Mills and the Clerk was instructed to write to
Messrs Towgood and Beckwith to ask what steps they were prepared to take to
prevent this having regard to the work that the Board intends to do

(b) He also stated that the South Drain to Lolham Bridges would have to be
attended to in the near future as would the feed drain leading to the North Fen
Pump

(c) He reported that he considered that seven or 8 men should be treated as a
minimum number for the permanent labour force and he was authorized to advertise
to obtain this and it was decided to consider in the near future the advisability
of the Board having its own transport

(d) He reported that as far as he was aware the North Fen Pump and the work in
connection with installing it was now completed and he was instructed to get in
touch with the Regional Engineer at Lincoln to make a final inspection which would
enable the Board to obtain a Grant from the Ministry.

(e) He reported that as soon as the outstanding fences had been erected which he
would see to he would do likewise in respect of ~~this scheme~~ *the River Bank Scheme.*

(f) He reported that he considered the new flap which it had been intended to
be installed at the point where Northborough Drain adjoins the new Cut would be a
waste of money and he said that the new flap which had been delivered could be
used in connection with Brook Drain and it was decided to take no further action
with reference to this.

(g) He was authorised to buy the following at a figure between £100 and £120 :

Dumpy Level
Staff and Tripod
Half a dozen range poles
100ft tape
Drawing Board and T.Square

It was further decided that should these instruments be used by him in connection
with his work as Engineer of the Newborough Drainage Board that that Board should
be asked to contribute towards their purchase

4. The question of Mr Horsford's superannuation was considered as a Contributory
Employee and in order that he should be so treated the following resolution was
unanimously passed:

It was resolved that this Board specifies Mr D.S.S.Horsford its Engineer as a
Contributory Employee within the meaning of Section 3 of the Local Government
Superannuation Act 1937 as from the 23rd February 1961.

6. The estimate of Mr P.Warr King of the 17th February last for clearing thorn and briars on the North Soke Drain was considered and it was decided to postpone further consideration until the next Board Meeting

7. The Clerk was instructed to write to the Soke of Peterborough County Council with reference to the possibility of the County Council taking over the liability for all the Board's bridges

8. The Clerk reported that he had had a letter from the Town Clerk with reference to the proposed laying of water mains through part of the Board's area. The Engineer reported that he had no comments to make and the Clerk was instructed to write to the Town Clerk accordingly

9. The Clerk reported the correspondence he had had with the County Council Surveyor relating to the piping in of one of the Board's drains on the Maxey-Market Deeping Road and it was decided that he should ask the Surveyor to meet the Chairman and the Engineer on the site

10. The Board authorized the Rate Collector to take proceedings for the recovery of the arrears of rates in the 15 outstanding cases.
