The Clerk reported that he had written to the Soke of Peterborough County Council and the reply was that they had asked for a complete list of the bridges concerned and the Engineer would prepare this when possible

It was proposed by Mr Robinson seconded by Mr Jackson and carried unanimously that the Rate for the General District for the current year should be 5/8d ie Owner's rate 1/- and Occupier's rate 4/8d and for the North Fen District 14/2d namely Owner's rate 2/6d and Occupier's rate 11/8d and it was proposed and seconded by the same persons that the Rates should be sealed
6. The Clerk was instructed to write to the Welland River Board with regard to the scrub on the North side of the new Cut from Lolham to Peakirk on the bank below the fence erected by the River Board and that a request should be made for this scrub to be cleared.

7. It was proposed by Mr Perkins seconded by Mr Jackson and carried that Mr Samuel Egar should be a Member of the Finance Committee to which Mr Egar agreed
8. It was resolved in connection with the Brook Drain Scheme that the Board should be responsible for the fencing of permanent pasture

1. The Minutes of the meeting held on the 14th October, 1961 were read and confirmed and signed by the Chairman.
2. On the matters arising from the Minutes the following items were discussed:-

(a) Towgood and Beckwith Ltd.

The Clerk reported that he had written as requested but had had no reply and he was asked to write again in connection with the steps they were taking with regard to the fouling of the Board's drains

(b) The Board's bridges.

The Engineer reported that he had not yet compiled a list for submission to the Sole of Peterborough County Council

(c) The Drain along the Helpston - Glington Road.

It was reported that the Rural District Council had had the silt removed

(d) Scrub on the North side of the new Cut

The Clerk reported that he had written to the Welland River Board but had received no answer and he was asked to write again.

(e) The Clerk reported that he had written to Mr. Broughton with regard to fencing along the land adjoining the Flax Pit Drain and Mr. Broughton's letter in reply was read to the meeting. It was agreed that the Chairman and the Engineer should meet Mr. Broughton on the site to discuss the matter

water level as affected by the new Cut was then discussed and the Clerk was instructed to write to the Welland River Board to suggest that that Board should meet a delegation from this Board and that Messrs. L. H. Vergette, A. Crowson, J. D. Perrins, W. Jackson and S. Eggar should represent the Board, and that at the same time the question of getting rid of the water in flood time in the Pingle Lane area at Northborough should be discussed.

4. Brook Drain Scheme The Engineer submitted his scheme for the consideration of the Board the cost of which he estimated to be £10,000 (Ten thousand pounds) of which £1,000 would be provided by the Solve of Peterborough in connection with the new Pealirk Bridge. The Engineer's Report was accepted and he was instructed to proceed and on the proposition of Mr. Neaverson, seconded by Mr. Jackson, it was agreed that a fifty per cent grant should be applied for and that the balance should be paid out of revenue. It was also agreed but left with the Engineer that where possible the excavated silt should be put on the side of the drain opposite to the side upon which it had been put when the drains had been last cleaned out.

5. Mr. Broughton mentioned the possibility of putting in Slackers in the Bainton Brook and Flax Pit drains so as to hold up water when there was lack of it and the Engineer was asked to give an estimate of what he thinks such Slackers would cost.
