1. The Minutes of the Meetings held on the 5th July 1962 and 10th September 1962 were read and confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

2. On the matters arising from the minutes the following items were mentioned

(a) Towgood and Beckwith Limited - The Clerk reported that he had written a further letter to the above named and the matter had now been dealt with by them and the Engineer to the Board.

(b) Scrub on the North side of the New Cut. It was reported that the Welland River Board had been written to and it had now been agreed with that Board that the liability belonged to this Board and the matter had been dealt with on this basis.

(c) The Chairman reported that he had seen Mr. Broughton with regard to the fencing of the land adjacent to Flax Pit Drain and that it had been agreed with Mr. Broughton that when that land was laid down to pasture he would erect an electric fence.

3. The Clerk read a letter to the Board from Mr. T.A. Rollings enclosing his resignation for reasons of health and this resignation was accepted with regret and the Clerk was asked to write to Mr. Rollings accordingly.

4. The matter of the water level as affected by the new cut was discussed at length and Mr. Broughton ~~wrote to~~ the Board and subsequently handed to the Clerk a statement setting out his view and the Clerk was instructed to write to the Welland River Board again with a copy of this statement and asking ~~them~~ for a meeting to be arranged with the Welland River Board's Engineer so that this matter can be discussed afresh.

5. With regard to the complaints about the use to which the Board's drain had been put by Mr. Whittton at Glington the Clerk was instructed to write to him with regard to this.

6. The Engineer to the Board reported that early in October there was an agreed rise in the rates of pay payable to agricultural workers which would affect the Board's employees, and the Engineer was given authority to implement this rise in wages.

7. It was agreed that the rating officer should be given authority to institute or defend on behalf of the Board proceedings in relation to the drainage rates due to the Board before a Court of ~~small~~ <sup>summary</sup> jurisdiction for the issue of a Warrant for distress for failure to pay drainage rates

8. It was however agreed that Section 22 and 23 of the Land drainage Act 1962 should have effect to the following provisions:-

That the value at which the rates ~~are~~ <sup>is</sup> assessed shall be the value arrived at by taking one third of the rateable value so shown and applying thereto the relative fraction arrived at in accordance

with the provision<sup>4</sup> of subsections 3 to 6 of Section 23 of the Land Drainage Act 1962

9. It was further agreed that this Board should join<sup>d</sup> the Association of Drainage Authorities and the Clerk was instructed to do what is necessary.

10. The report of the District Auditor relating to the audited accounts for the year ending 31st March 1961 was considered and these accounts were approved.

11. It was proposed by Mr *J. N. Perkins* seconded by Mr *A. Anderson* and carried that the rate for the General District for the current year should be 5/8d. ie Owner's rate 1/- Occupier's rate 4/8d and for the North Fen District should be 14/2d ie Owner's rate 2/6d and Occupier's Rate 11/8d and it was proposed and seconded by the same persons that the rates should be sealed.
