

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

NORTH WELLAND INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD.

WHEREAS the North Welland Internal Drainage Board by virtue of the powers vested in them by Section 47 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, on the sixteenth day of January, 1942 made a certain Byelaw for securing the efficient working of the drainage system in their district;

AND WHEREAS the Board have submitted the said Byelaw to the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") for confirmation;

NOW THEREFORE the Minister, in pursuance of the powers vested in him under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, and any other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby confirms the said Byelaw, a true copy thereof being annexed hereto.

BYE-LAW

The North Welland Internal Drainage Board under and by virtue of the powers and authority vested in them by the Land Drainage Act, 1930, do make the following Bye-law, which they consider necessary for securing the efficient working of the drainage system in their district.

An Owner or Occupier using or causing or permitting to be used any bank of any watercourse for the purpose of grazing or keeping any animal thereon shall take such steps as are necessary and reasonably practicable by way of fencing or otherwise to prevent the bank or watercourse from being damaged by such use.

PROVIDED that nothing in this Bye-law shall prevent the use of the drain for watering Cattle and other Stock if a proper and sufficient watering place is constructed by the Owner or occupier to the satisfaction of the Engineer for the time being of the Board.

N.B.-Every person who fails to comply with the foregoing Bye-law shall be liable on summary conviction in respect of each offence to a Fine not exceeding £20.

And a further Fine not exceeding £5 for every day on which the offence is committed or continued.
