

and the Passage over the said Wash shall be made safe and commodious at all Times of Tide, and in all Seasons, it shall be lawful for the said Trustees, or such Person or Persons as they, or any Five or more of them, shall appoint; and they are hereby authorized and empowered, for ever after, to take the following Tolls or Pontage; *videlicet*,

For every Coach, Chariot, Landau, Berlin, Chaise, Calash, Chair, or Hearse, with Four Wheels, and drawn by less than Four Horses, the Sum of Sixpence; and if by Four or more, the Sum of One Shilling:

For every Chair or Pleasure Cart, drawn by One Horse, Three-pence; and by Two Horses, Sixpence:

For every Waggon, Wain, or other Carriage with Four Wheels, and drawn by Three or Four Horses or more, the Sum of One Shilling and Sixpence; and by Two Horses, One Shilling:

For every Cart or other Carriage not above specified, and drawn by Two or more Horses, Nine-pence; and by One Horse, Sixpence:

For every Horse, Mare, Gelding, Mule, or Ass, laden or unladen, and not drawing, the Sum of Three Halfpence:

For every Drove of Oxen or Neat Cattle, Ten-pence *per* Score, and so in Proportion for any greater or less Number:

And for every Drove of Swine, Calves, Sheep, or Lambs, Five-pence *per* Score, and so in Proportion for any greater or less Number:

Tolls, how to be recovered.

Which said respective Sums shall be demanded and taken as and in the Name of a Toll: And if any Person or Persons, subject to the Payment of any of the said Tolls, shall, after Demand thereof made, neglect or refuse to pay the same, or any Part thereof, or if the said Tolls shall be evaded by passing over the said Wash at any of the other Bridges herein directed to be made over the said new River or Cut, or at any other Place in the same, it shall be lawful for the Person or Persons appointed as aforesaid to collect such Tolls, and he is hereby required to seize or distrain any Horse or Horses, or other Cattle, Beasts or Goods, or any Carriage upon which such Tolls are by this Act imposed, or any other of the Goods and Chattels of any Person or Persons who ought to pay the same; and if such Tolls, and the reasonable Charges of following the Person or Persons who ought to pay the same, and of such Seizure and Distress are not paid, the Person or Persons so seizing and distraining shall and may sell the Horse and Horses, Cattle, Carriage, or Goods and Chattels so seized and distrained, returning the Overplus, (if any be), upon Demand, to the Owner thereof, after such Tolls and all reasonable Charges of such Distress and Sale shall be deducted and paid.

XLVIII. Provided that the Trustees last appointed shall not be authorized or empowered to demand or take any of the Tolls herein-before mentioned, until the Trustees first herein named, or any Seven or more of them, shall, by a Certificate under their Hands, to be delivered to the Justices at some General Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the Parts of *Elloe* in *Holland*, in the said County of *Lincoln*, declare that the said intended Bridge over the said Cut is completed, and the Passage over the

the said Wash, from the said South Bank, in the Parish of *Moulton* aforesaid, to the said North Bank, in the said Parish of *Fosdike*, is rendered safe and commodious for Passengers and Cattle at all Times of Tide, and in all Seasons, which said last-mentioned Trustees, shall and they are hereby required to sign the said Certificate as soon as may be after the Passage over the said Wash shall be rendered safe and commodious as aforesaid.

XLIX. Provided always, That nothing herein contained shall extend, or be construed to extend, to enforce the Payment of Tolls from any Person going on Horseback, or with Cattle or Carriages, *bona fide*, to and from Lands lying between the present Sea Bank and the intended new Cut, that will be intersected by the said new River or Cut; but that all such Horses, Cattle, and Carriages, shall have free Liberty to pass over the said Bridge Toll-free; any Thing herein contained to the contrary thereof notwithstanding.

Not to extend to Persons going to and from Lands intersected by the new Cut.

L. And be it further enacted, That the said Commissioners may, and they are hereby empowered, at any Meeting to be holden in pursuance of this Act, to borrow and take up at Interest any Sum or Sums of Money that they shall think proper, upon the Credit of the Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, payable by virtue of this Act; and to mortgage, assign, and convey over, the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, or any Part or Parts thereof, by any Writing or Writings under their Hands and Seals, (the Charges of such Assignments and Conveyances to be paid out of such Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage), to any Person or Persons who shall advance and lend their Monies thereon, as a Security or Securities for the several Sums of Money that shall be so borrowed, and the Interest thereof; and the Money so to be borrowed on the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, shall be applied in such Manner, and for such Purposes only, as the Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, so assigned and conveyed, are hereby directed to be applied; and that Copies of all such Mortgages, Assignments, and Conveyances, shall be entered in a Book or Books to be kept for that Purpose by the Clerk to the said Commissioners; but no Money shall be borrowed on the Credit of the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, after the First Meeting of the said Commissioners, unless Notice for that Purpose be inserted in the *Lincoln, Rutland, and Stamford Mercury*, and in the *Cambridge Chronicle*, at least Fourteen Days before the borrowing of such Money: And all and every Person or Persons to whom any such Mortgage, Assignment, or Conveyance, shall be made as aforesaid, or who shall be entitled to the same, is and are hereby empowered, from Time to Time, by an Indorsement under his, her, or their Hand or Hands, to be made on his, her, or their Security or Securities, or by any other Writing or Writings under his, her, or their Hand and Seal, or Hands and Seals, to be duly executed in the Presence of Two or more credible Witnesses, to assign over or transfer such Security or Securities, or any Share thereof, and all or any Part of the Monies due thereon, to any Person or Persons whomsoever; all which Assignments and Transfers shall be produced or notified to the Clerk of the said Commissioners and Trustees respectively, within Forty Days after the Date thereof; and such Clerk shall cause an Entry or Memorial to be made of every such Transfer, specifying the Date thereof, and the Names, Additions, and Places of Abode, of the several

several Parties, and the Sum or Sums therein mentioned to be transferred, and the Names, Additions, and Places of Abode, of the Witnesses to the Execution thereof, in the said Book or Books to be kept for entering the said original Mortgages, Assignments, or Conveyances, for which the said Clerk shall be paid Two Shillings and Sixpence, and no more, by the Person or Persons to whom such respective Assignments or Transfers shall be made, which said Book or Books may be inspected at all reasonable Times by any Person or Persons whomsoever, and the Sum of One Shilling, and no more, shall be paid to such Clerk for every such Inspection; and after such Entry made, and not otherwise, such Assignments or Transfers respectively, shall entitle the Assignee or Assignees, his, her, and their Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, to the Benefit thereof and Payment thereon; and every such Assignee may in like Manner assign again, and so *toties quoties*; and the Person or Persons to whom such Security or Securities, or any such Assignment or Assignments thereof shall be made, and his, her, or their respective Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, shall be Creditors upon the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, in an equal Degree one with another, and shall not have any Preference with respect to the Priority of Assignment or of advancing such Monies aforesaid.

Treasurer or Receiver to pay the Interest of the Monies borrowed.

LI. And be it further enacted, That the Treasurer of the said Commissioners and Trustees respectively, shall, out of the Monies coming to his Hands by virtue of this Act, duly and regularly pay the Interest of all and every the said Mortgages which shall be made or given by the said Commissioners in pursuance of this Act as aforesaid, by Half-yearly Payments, as and when the same shall become due.

In Default of Payment, Taxes to vest in Creditors.

LII. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That in Default of Payment of the Interest due on such respective Mortgages, or of the said principal Monies after such Notice as aforesaid, the several Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage before mentioned, or such of them or such Part or Parts, Share or Shares thereof respectively, as shall have been made liable to, and charged and chargeable with the said respective Mortgages, shall thereupon respectively vest in the Persons entitled to such Mortgages, until the same shall be fully paid and satisfied, together with the Costs and Charges occasioned by the Non-payment of the same; and the said Mortgagees and Obligees respectively, and their respective Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, shall have the same Powers, Rights, Privileges, and Remedies of recovering, collecting, and receiving the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, or such Share or Shares, Part or Parts thereof, as shall be so vested in them respectively, as the said Commissioners or Trustees, or their several Collectors or Receivers, could have had, in case the said Mortgages had not been made.

The Monies borrowed to be carried to the same Account with the Taxes.

LIII. And be it further enacted, That all and every the Monies which shall be borrowed and raised on the said several Mortgages and Securities aforesaid, shall be carried and placed to the respective Accounts herein-before directed to be kept.

Application of the Money borrowed on the Taxes.

LIV. And be it further enacted, That the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, and the Money to arise by Mortgage of the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, as herein-before mentioned, and all pecuniary Penalties and Forfeitures

Forfeitures to be recovered or levied by virtue of this Act, not hereby otherwise disposed of, shall be applied by the said Commissioners previous to the Execution of their Award herein-after directed in Manner following; (that is to say), in the First Place, in paying and defraying all such Subscriptions as have been made for procuring previous Surveys and Reports, and towards the obtaining of this Act, and all Costs and Charges which shall have been incurred in making such previous Surveys and Reports, and in obtaining and passing this Act; and, in the next Place, in keeping down the Interest as herein-before directed, for and towards the several Works hereby directed to be done and executed by the said Commissioners, and towards the Support and Maintenance of the same, and of carrying the several Powers and Authorities herein contained into effectual Execution; and after the Execution of the said Award, then the said Taxes, Tolls, Pontage, pecuniary Penalties, and Forfeitures shall be, and the same are hereby vested in the Trustees herein-after appointed to act after the said Execution of the Award, and shall be applied in like Manner by the said Trustees.

LV. And be it further enacted, That in case the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, intended as a Fund for supporting the several Works herein directed, shall prove insufficient for those Purposes, it shall be lawful for a Majority of the Trustees herein next appointed, who shall be present at any Meeting to be held by them for that Purpose, of which Meeting, as also the Purpose thereof, One Month's previous Notice shall be given by Advertisements in the *Lincoln, Rutland, and Stamford Mercury* and *Cambridge Chronicle*, to agree to such Increase of the said Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, as to the said Majority shall seem fit and expedient, so as the same be not more than One Half of the original Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, herein directed to be laid: Provided always, that such Increase of the Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, shall be in due Proportion with the original Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, herein directed to be laid, and the same and every of them shall be recoverable by the said Commissioners, and shall be applied by them in like Manner as the Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, hereby originally directed to be laid, are herein declared to be recoverable and directed to be applied; and it shall be lawful for the said Commissioners, and they are hereby authorized to borrow Money thereon by Way of Mortgage; which Mortgages shall be transferable, and shall be as good and effectual in the Law to all Intents and Purposes, as the several Mortgages on and Assignments of the Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage, herein directed to be originally laid.

Taxes, Tolls, and Pontage may be increased.

LVI. And be it further enacted, That until the Execution of the Award of the Commissioners as herein after mentioned, the Most Noble Duke of *Ancafter*, the Right Honourable Lord *Willoughby de Broke*, the Right Honourable Lord *Boston*, the Right Honourable Lord *Brownlow*, the Right Honourable Lord *Romney*, the Right Honourable Lord *Eardley*, Sir *John Trollope* Baronet, Sir *Gilbert Heathcote* Baronet, Sir *Joseph Banks* Baronet, Sir *Thomas Whichcote* Baronet, *Robert Smith*, *Joshua Scrope*, *Willoughby Wood*, *Thomas Hogard*, *Fairfax Johnson*, *Henry Boulton*, *Rogers Parker*, *George Pochin*, *Theophilus Buckworth*, *Theophilus Buckworth junior*, *Thomas Buckworth*, *William Tatam*, *Samuel Greaves*, *James Digby*, *John Kelk*, *Samuel Barnard*, *Thomas Tunnard*, *John Tunnard*, *Samuel Tunnard*, *Richard Yerburch*, *John George Calthrop*, *Francis Thirkill*, *William Bailey*

*Bailey junior, Henry Hawkes, John Grundy Thompson, Thomas Pulvertoft, Thomas Hawkes, Henry Clarke, Thomas Wilson, John Milnes, John Deane Hogard, Robert Parr,* and every Lord or Lady of a Manor, Improprator, Rector, or Vicar for the Time being, within the Boundary of the Lands hereby directed to be drained; also every Lord or Lady of a Manor, Improprator, Rector, or Vicar for the Time being, in such other Parishes through which the said new River or Cut, or any Part thereof shall be made, and their several and respective Successors and legal real Representatives for the Time being, shall be, and they are hereby appointed Trustees for the said Navigation and Drainage, and all Works relating to the said Navigation and Drainage are hereby vested in them as Trustees for the Purposes of this Act: Provided always, that the Trustees appointed as above, shall have Power to nominate and appoint respective Agents, under their several Hands, to act for them in the several Matters and Things herein empowered or required to be done by the said Trustees.

LVII. And be it further enacted, That the said Commissioners shall, and they are hereby required to keep an Account in Writing of all Monies which they shall receive, or shall borrow or assess on the respective Proprietors, for the Purpose of carrying into Execution this Act, or lay out in or about the said intended Works, and of all and every other Expenditure relating thereto; and shall at all and every of the Meetings of the said Commissioners, to be held in pursuance of this Act, permit the said Trustees herein-before appointed, or any Five or more of them, to inspect such Accounts with the Vouchers for any Money charged to have been paid by the said Commissioners; and the said Trustees, or any Five or more of them, are hereby authorized and empowered, from Time to Time, to settle and sign such Accounts with the said Commissioners, and to direct all such Sums of Money as may remain in the Hands of the said Commissioners, or their Treasurer or Treasurers, after the Execution of the said Works shall be completed by the said Commissioners, to be paid to the Superintendant for the Time being, and to give Discharges for all such Sums of Money.

LVIII. And be it further enacted, That the said Commissioners, as soon as conveniently may be, after they have completed the said new River or Cut, and other Works directed by them to be made and done by this Act, and the Assessment, Tax, or Charge, herein directed to be made, shall form and draw up, or cause to be formed and drawn up, an Award or Instrument in Writing, which shall express and specify the Quantity in Statute Measure of Acres, Roods, and Perches, of the Lands and Grounds so taxed by them as aforesaid, and the Quantity herein-before directed to be taxed by the Court of Sewers, according to the accustomed Mode of raising and levying Dyke Reeve Rates, by the computed Number of Acres; and the Quantity of Land belonging to each Proprietor therein, and the Names of the several and respective Tenants thereof, with a Description of the Situation, Abutments, and Boundaries of the same, and the Quantity of Acres, Roods, and Perches, in each of the said respective Parishes, Places, and Commons, so taxed by them as aforesaid, with an Account of the Annual Sums so charged upon them respectively, and the Quota to be paid and borne by the several and respective Proprietors, and also the Quota to be borne by the respective Com-

mons;

mons; and they the said Commissioners are hereby required to set down and express in their said Award an Account of the Bridges, Drains, and other Works, belonging to the said new River or Cut, and which shall be built, removed, made, and executed, by the Commissioners, in pursuance of this Act, together with an Account of all and singular other the Banks, Drains, Sluices, Cloughs, Bridges, Tunnels, Fences, Stiles, Gates, and other Works, which by the said Act shall be deemed to be vested in, and to be under the Controul, Authority, and Jurisdiction of the said Trustees; and Two Parts of the said Award or Instrument in Writing shall be signed and sealed by the said Commissioners, and One Part thereof, shall, as soon as may be after such signing and sealing as aforesaid, be enrolled with the Clerk of the Peace for the Parts of *Holland*, in the said County of *Lincoln*, and a Copy of the Enrolment, attested by the said Clerk of the Peace, or his sufficient Deputy or Deputies, shall from Time to Time be admitted in all Courts whatsoever as legal Evidence; which Copy the said Clerk of the Peace, or his Deputy or Deputies, is and are hereby required to make and deliver to any Person or Persons whomsoever desiring the same, he, she, or they, paying for such Copy after the Rate of Two pence *per* Sheet, (reckoning Seventy-two Words to each Sheet); and every Person shall have Liberty to inspect and peruse the Enrolment of the said Award, paying for every such Inspection or Perusal One Shilling, and no more; and that the same Award, and all Matters done by the said Commissioners, in pursuance of this Act, shall be binding and conclusive unto and upon all Parties interested therein; and after the Enrolment of the said Award, One Part thereof shall be delivered by the said Commissioners to the said Trustees, at any of their Meetings to be held in pursuance of this Act, and the other Part thereof shall be lodged in the Town Chest belonging to the Parish of *Spalding* aforesaid.

LIX. And be it further enacted, That after the Execution of the said Award by the said Commissioners, the Power of the said Commissioners, and also of the Trustees herein-before appointed, shall cease, and be for ever extinguished, and that from thenceforth every Lord or Lady of a Manor, Rector, Improprator, or Vicar for the Time being, within the Boundary of the Lands hereby directed to be taxed, whether the same are included in the Lands herein particularly described, or are included on Petition as herein provided for, the Right Honourable Lord *Willoughby de Broke*, or the Owner or Owners for the Time being of the Estate now belonging to him in *Frampton* aforesaid; the President and Scholars for the Time being of the College of *Saint Mary Magdalen*, in the University of *Oxford*, and their Lessee for the Time being of the said Salt Marsh; the Mayor, and Two Persons to be appointed by the Mayor, Aldermen, and Common Councilmen, of the Borough of *Boston* for the Time being; the Mayor and senior Alderman of the Borough of *Stamford* for the Time being; the Owner or Owners for the Time being of the Navigation of the said River *Welland*, from *Stamford* to *Deeping Saint James*, or his, her, or their Lessee; any Three Persons to be chosen annually out of the Merchants resident within the Town of *Spalding*; any Two Persons to be chosen annually out of the Proprietors of the Salt Marshes on the South Side of the present Channel; any Two Persons to be elected by the Parish of *Holbeach*; any Two Persons to be elected by the Parish of *Wapload*; any Two Persons to be elected by the Parish of *Moulton*; any Two

Two Persons to be elected by the Parish of *Frampton*; any Two Persons to be elected by the Parish of *Wyberton*; any Six Persons to be chosen annually out of the Body of Adventurers, or Owners of Taxable Lands, in *Deeping Fen* aforesaid; any Three Persons to be chosen annually out of the Proprietors of Free Lands, within the said *Deeping Fen*; any Three Persons to be chosen annually out of the Proprietors, within the Parts of *Holland*, in the said County, having Right of Common on the said Commons, and paying Taxes as aforesaid; any Three Persons to be chosen annually out of the Proprietors, within the Parts of *Kesteven*, in the said County, having Right of Common on the said Commons, and paying Taxes as aforesaid; the Owner or Owners of *Posland* Estate for the Time being, or his, her, or their known Agent; any One Person to be chosen annually out of the Proprietors of Estates in each Parish, paying Taxes as aforesaid; every Owner or Proprietor of Three hundred Acres of Land, paying Taxes as aforesaid; *Samuel Barnard* Esquire, *Samuel Tunnard* Esquire, and also every Lessee under the Crown, of Three hundred Acres or more of Land, paying Taxes as aforesaid; shall be, and they are hereby severally appointed Trustees for the future Care and Management of the said Navigation and Drainage: Provided always, that it shall be lawful as well for the said Lord *Willoughby de Broke*, and the said President and Scholars respectively, as for every Lord or Lady of a Manor, Rector, Improprator, or Vicar for the Time being; and also the said Mayor, and Two Persons so appointed by the said Mayor, Aldermen, and Common Council of the Borough of *Boston* for the Time being as aforesaid, by Writing under their Common Seal; and every Owner of Three hundred Acres of Land, paying Taxes as aforesaid, by Writing under his, her, or their Hand or Hands, from Time to Time, and for such Time as he, she, or they shall think fit, to appoint an Agent or Deputy to act in his, her, or their Absence, as a Trustee for the said Navigation and Drainage, such Agent or Deputy not being a Trustee in his own Right.

Trustees how

LX. And be it further enacted, That it shall be lawful for the said Merchants, resident in the Town of *Spalding*, the said Adventurers of *Deeping Fen*, and Owners of Taxable and Free Lands in *Deeping Fen* aforesaid; and also for the said Proprietors in each of the said Parts of *Holland* and *Kesteven*, having Right of Common on the said Commons respectively; and for the said Proprietors of Lands within the said *Quadrant* Hundred, and also within each of the said Parishes paying Taxes as aforesaid; and also for the said Proprietors of Salt Marshes on the South Side of the present Channel, and of Lands in each of the said Parishes of *Holbeach*, *Wapload*, *Moulton*, *Frampton*, and *Wyberton*, to hold Annual Meetings respectively, at any Time and Place that they shall think proper, within Two Months previous to the Annual Meetings of the said Trustees herein-after appointed; and also to hold Special Meetings, in case of Death or Resignation of any Trustees respectively, appointed under the Authority of this Act, and at such several Meetings to appoint a Chairman, and elect either annually, or for the Purpose of filling up Vacancies as aforesaid, the several and respective Persons hereby authorized to act as Trustees on the Part of the said Merchants, Adventurers, Owners, and Proprietors respectively; and such several Persons shall be appointed under the Hand and Seal of the Chairman of the said several Meetings, and the several Appointments shall be lodged in the Hands of the

the Clerk to the said Trustees, to be by him kept amongst the other Papers belonging to the said Trustees, and shall be good and effectual in the Law to all Intents and Purposes whatsoever.

LXI. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That after such First Appointments as aforesaid, in case the said several Bodies of Merchants, Adventurers, Owners, and Proprietors respectively, shall neglect annually to appoint such several Persons to act for them, or to fill up Vacancies as aforesaid, it shall be lawful for the several Persons appointed at any previous Meeting to continue to act as Trustees for the Purposes of this Act, until further Appointments shall be severally made; any Thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding.

On Non-appointment, former Trustees to act.

LXII. And be it further enacted, That, from and after the Execution of the Award of the said Commissioners, the said Trustees last appointed shall meet together at the Town Hall in *Spalding* aforesaid, on the Second Tuesday after the Fourth Day of May then next following, and proceed to the further Execution of this Act, and shall and may adjourn themselves from Time to Time, and meet at the same or any other Place as often as the said Trustees, or the Majority of them present, shall think proper; and if at any Meeting appointed to be held by virtue of this Act, there shall not appear Five Trustees to act and to adjourn to another Day, or in case the Trustees shall omit or neglect to adjourn themselves, that then, or in either of the said Cases, their Clerk or Clerks shall, by Notice in Writing, to be affixed on the Church Doors of the several Parishes within the Purview of this Act, at least Ten Days before the next Meeting, appoint the Trustees to meet at the same Place where the last Meeting was appointed to be held on that Day Fortnight after the Day on which such last Meeting was appointed; and the said Trustees at their Meetings shall bear and pay their own Expenses.

LXIII. And be it further enacted, That the said Trustees last appointed, or their Successors, or such of them as shall think proper to meet as aforesaid, or such of their Agents as shall have been appointed in Writing, in that Behalf, shall, and they are hereby required annually to meet on the said Second Tuesday after the Fourth Day of May in every Year, at the Town Hall, or any other Place in *Spalding* aforesaid; and then and there to settle the Accounts of the Treasurer, Superintendent, and other Officers who shall have been previously appointed by the said Commissioners, and discharge them of their several Trusts and Offices, and thence forward, by Writing under their Hands, to appoint a Treasurer or Treasurers, Sluice and Staunch Keepers, Toll Collectors, Superintendants, and other Officers, with such several Salaries, except to the said Treasurer or Treasurers, as they shall think proper, which Salaries shall be mentioned in such several Appointments; and after the said new River or Cut, Haling Ways, navigable Staunches, Sea Sluice and other Sluices, Bridges, and other Works herein-before provided for, shall be perfected by Order of the said Commissioners, and they shall have made their Award as herein-before directed, the said new River or Cut, Haling Ways, and navigable Staunches, Sea Sluice, and other Sluices, Lock and Sluice Keepers Houses, and Toll House, Bridges, Banks, Headings, Cloughs, Tunnels, Fences, Gates, Stiles, and other Works herein provided for, shall be, and the same and every of them are hereby for ever vested in the said

Appointment of Superintendent.

After the Execution of the Award, new Cut, and other Works vested in Trustees.
