

**MARKET DEEPING, ST. JAMES'S & WEST DEEPING.**

**MARKET DEEPING**, a market-town and parish, in the hundred of Ness and division of Kesteven, is 90 miles from London and 8 from Stamford, situated among the fens, on the north side of the river Welland, and on the lowest land in the whole county. The church is dedicated to St. Guthlake, the living of which is a vicarage, in the patronage of the King, and in the incumbency of the Rev. Joseph Monkhouse. Here is a small endowed free school, for the education of sixteen poor children, and the master has a house attached. The weekly market is held on Wednesday, and fairs the 10th of October and second Wednesday in May (old style). The population of this parish, in 1821, consisted of 1,016 inhabitants.

**ST. JAMES'S, OR EAST DEEPING**, is a village of considerable length, commencing a little more than a quarter of a mile from Market Deeping, and contains a church, dedicated to St. James, the living of which is in the gift of Sir C. Whichcot, Bart. This church was originally erected as a chapel, by the monks of Croyland abbey, and afterwards converted into a parish church by Richard de Rulos. The number of inhabitants in this place, by the last census, was 1,385.

**WEST DEEPING** is about a quarter of a mile west of Market Deeping, and also contains a church, the living of which is a rectory, in the patronage of the King. About 300 inhabitants form the population of this village.

**MARKET RASEN,**

COMMONLY, but improperly written *Raisen*, and sometimes *Raisin*, is a small and well-built market town, situated on the small stream called the Rase, from which it takes its name. It is in the hundred of Walshcroft, distant from London 148 miles, and from Lincoln and Louth sixteen. The town has an air of neatness and cleanness about it, that immediately prepossesses the stranger in its favour; and the surrounding country, though generally flat, is extremely fertile and beautiful. There is no trade carried on here, except retail trade, and there is nothing remarkable in the town, except the peculiar form of the upper windows, in the embattled tower of the church, which have a pointed arch divided into two pointed lights, and a quatrefoil head; up the centre goes a strong

mullion, crossed by a transom, terminating at the imposts; on the south side of the tower is a representation of our first parent on the branches of a fruit tree, on the trunk of which is the dart of death; it allusion to the effects of eating the forbidden fruit. In the endowment of this living, the vicar is entitled to the unusual tithe of ale. The living is in the patronage of the King, and the present incumbent is the Rev. Edward Walter. The Roman catholics, methodists, and independents have each a chapel here, with Sunday schools attached, besides which there is a national school for boys and another for girls. The market day is Tuesday, and the annual fair on the 25th of September. The population of the parish of Market Rase, in 1821, was 1,166.
