Sir,

I am directed by the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries to advert to your letter of the 12th ulto and in reply to say that they have received the report of their Special Commissioners upon the drainage conditions existing in the district of the Bourne South Fen and Thurlby Fen Drainage Board, and that it appears to them that the work required for that district should be considered in connexion with a comprehensive scheme of works for the improvement of the drainage in the areas of the Rivers Glen and Welland. The Board accordingly propose to endeavour to prepare a Provisional Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1914, setting up an authority competent to carry out all the necessary works in this larger area, and a further communication will in due course be made to you in the matter....
