Gentlemen,

I am directed by the Board of Trade to state that they have been informed that the River Welland Outfall Trustees are removing materials from the River Welland and are also constructing a jetty and executing other works below highwater mark near Fosdyke Bridge.


Upon the assumption that this information is correct, I am to request that you will favour the Board with plans and sections of the works in question shewing the lines and levels of high and low water of ordinary spring tides, together with a 25 inch Ordnance Map (not a cutting or tracing therefrom) having the sites of the works accurately marked thereon in some distinctive colour.

I am at the same time to inquire whether the Trustees claim to be executing the works under any statutory authority. If so I am to request that you will favour the Board with a reference to the Act and section by virtue of which the Trustees consider they are authorised to carry out the works.
