

Floors under Wash and Wing of Service — The platform or floor
being prepared and the concrete being filled in to a perfect level and
extended over with mortar are left as specified; a layer of good
sound red deals 4 inches thick
and wings of these placed on them above "the floor". The floor to be
spiked through to the floor joists tight with spikes 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. long & 2 in. by
two spikes to each plank one each side per.

With two outside planed off the floor in the form of the platform against
which the 1 inch shooting piles will be driven, are to be of ground sand
Kallie Number 12 mix 6 in. in section; to be spike down to the sleep
with spikes 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches long & 2 in. square; two spikes to each
crossing on each side of each plank.

Solid Aprons — The platform or beams, being prepared to level
surface, and the concrete being filled in to a perfect level; an apron
is to be laid down at the sea and land ends of the
service; consisting of a layer 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches thick of good sand
Kallie Number 12 spike down on all sides and wrought
iron surface on the edges.

The floor, when laid is to be fastened down to the platform with
through iron spikes 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches long & $\frac{1}{4}$ in. square, two spikes to
each crossing of each plank and timber in each sleep.
The heads of all the spikes to be sunk into the iron floor
through the surface of the above described floor of the service
and the shooting piles and fastenings on each end of them; tight, in
circular bolts $\frac{1}{2}$ in. diam. are to pass horizontally in the number
and positions shown on "the plans", having nuts and plate washers
 $4\frac{1}{2}$ $4\frac{1}{2}$ " at each end of the bolt; and the whole floor is to be secured
up firmly together.

Cement Grout under Solid Aprons. — After the floors of the solid
aprons are laid and fastened down, meat fat and cement forced to
be pumped underneath them by a force pump through pipes, forced in
to the floor, and the holes made for the pipes are to be plugged up
again with fine wood plugs or timbers.
